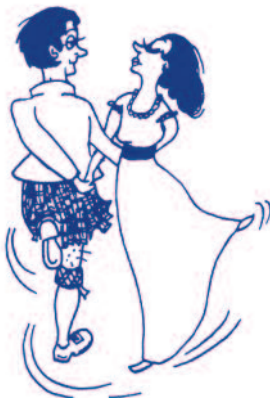

**Independent Age** is driven by the needs of older people, and supports them to lead independent and fulfilling lives. Our vision is of a society where older people can fulfil their aspirations, are valued and respected and given the opportunity to contribute fully to their communities.

**Independent Age** supports around 6,000 people with a regular grant for life, and a network of over 1,200 volunteer visitors. This commitment to lifelong financial and pastoral support is central to what we do. We also provide additional support to beneficiaries such as emergency grants, holidays and equipment and operate three care homes.

We focus our support on those over 70 who are ‘unsung heroes’ – people who have made a sustained and significant contribution in their communities but who are now unable to support themselves fully in their old age. These contributions can vary greatly, from volunteering in a charity shop consistently over a length of time to working in a local day centre.

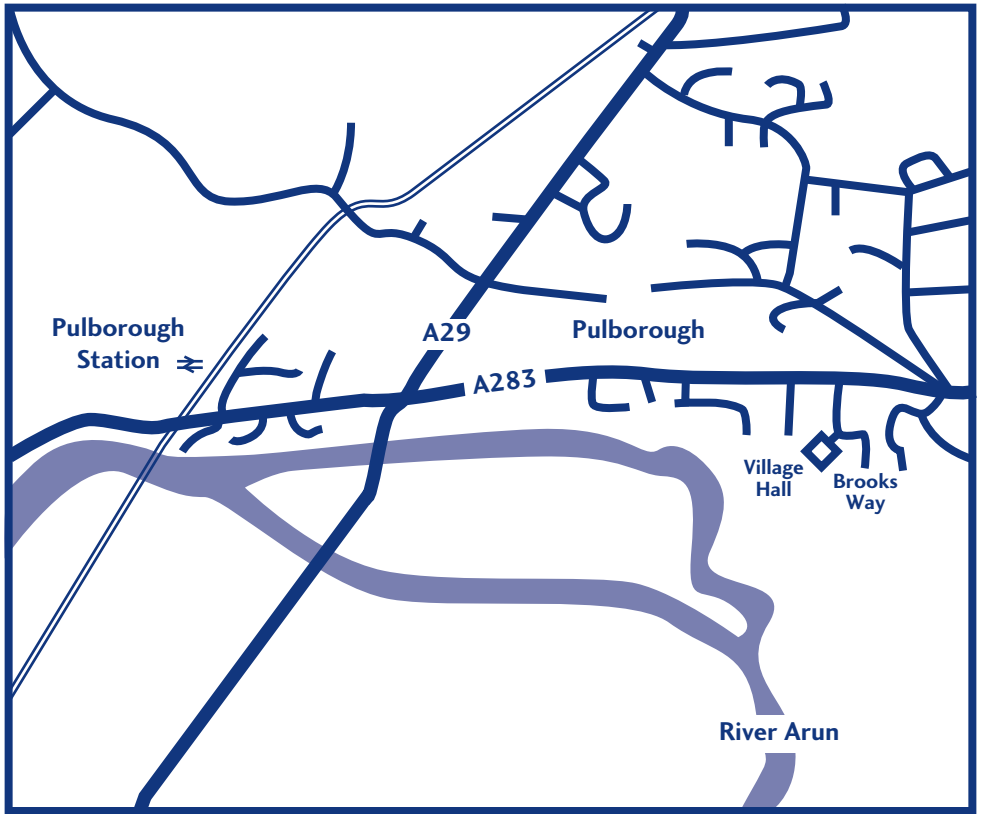
